

AN ORDINANCE NO. _____

Authorizing the City Manager to enter into an Airport Infrastructure Grant Agreement with the Federal Aviation Administration to accept funding in an amount up to \$140,733.00 for the acquisition of real property at the approach end of Runway 06 within the Airport Runway Safety Area at the Springfield-Beckley Municipal Airport; authorizing a local matching expenditure in an amount not to exceed \$7,821.00; authorizing the City Manager, Law Director, Airport Manager and the Director of Finance to do all things necessary for the execution of the agreement and to comply with all relevant local, state and federal legal requirements; and declaring an emergency therein.

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WHEREAS, the Federal Aviation Administration has made available funds in the amount of \$140,733.00 as part of the Airport Infrastructure Grant Project and this Commission considers it in the best interest of the public that said funding be accepted for the acquisition of real property at the approach end of Runway 06 within the Airport Runway Safety Area; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary that this Ordinance become effective immediately in order to comply with the timelines imposed by the Federal Aviation Administration, which creates an emergency to preserve the public peace, health, safety and property necessitating the immediate effectiveness of this Ordinance; NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Commission of The City of Springfield, Ohio, at least four of its members concurring:

Section 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into an Airport Infrastructure Grant Agreement with the Federal Aviation Administration, a copy of which is attached hereto and is hereby approved, to accept funding in an amount up to \$140,733.00, for the acquisition of real property at the approach end of Runway 06 within the Airport Runway Safety Area at the Springfield-Beckley Municipal Airport.

Section 2. That a local-matching expenditure in an amount not to exceed \$7,821.00 is hereby authorized.

Section 3. That the City Manager, Law Director, Airport Manager and the Director of Finance are hereby authorized to do all things necessary for the execution of the agreement, to comply with all relevant local, state and federal legal requirements.

Section 4. That by reason of the emergency set forth and defined in the preamble hereto, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately.
