WHEREAS, the City's Purchasing Division has advertised for and received bids for the purchase of Liquid Chlorine for use by the City's Water Treatment Plant; and

WHEREAS, after receiving and reviewing the bids submitted, the City's Purchasing Division has recommended an award of contract to Alexander Chemical Corporation for the purchase of Liquid Chlorine for use by the City's Water Treatment Plant for an amount not to exceed \$114,000.00, which was the lowest and best bidder: NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Commission of The City of Springfield, Ohio:

Section 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Alexander Chemical Corporation for the purchase of Liquid Chlorine for use by the City's Water Treatment Plant, for an amount not to exceed \$114,000.00.

Section 2. That the contract entered into by the City shall incorporate the specifications prepared by the Purchasing Division, which are hereby approved, and made available to providers submitting bids to the City, and shall conform to the recommendations of the City's Purchasing Division as made to this Commission.

Section 3. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after fourteen (14) days from the date of its passage.
