

AN ORDINANCE NO. 24-254

Authorizing the City Manager to apply for a FY2024 Safe Streets and Roads For All (SS4A) Grant in an amount up to \$1,576,560.00 through the United States Department of Transportation; authorizing a local matching expenditure in an amount not to exceed \$394,140.00; authorizing the City Manager, Director of Finance and Law Director to perform all acts and execute all documents considered necessary to fulfill the City's obligations under said Grant application, and to comply with all relevant local, state and federal legal requirements, and declaring an emergency therein.

WHEREAS, the City has been made aware of the availability funds in the amount of \$1,576,560.00 through the United States Department of Transportation, Safe Streets and Roads For All program; and

WHEREAS, this Commission considers it in the best interest of the public that such grant funds be applied for; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary that this Ordinance become effective immediately in order to comply with timelines imposed by the United States Department of Transportation, which creates an emergency to preserve the public peace, health, safety and property necessitating the immediate effectiveness of this Ordinance; NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Commission of The City of Springfield, Ohio, at least four of its members concurring:

Section 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to submit a Grant Application, to apply for a FY2024 Safe Streets and Roads For All (SS4A) Grant in an amount up to \$1,576,560.00 through the United States Department of Transportation Ambulance Transportation Program.

Section 2. That a local matching expenditure in an amount not to exceed \$394,140.00 is hereby authorized.



That the City Manager, Director of Finance and Law Director are hereby authorized to perform all acts and execute all documents considered necessary to fulfill the City's obligations under said Grant application, and to comply with all relevant local, state and federal legal requirements.
