

AN ORDINANCE NO. _____

Authorizing the City Manager to enter into a contract with OMAC Hauling Inc. for nuisance abatement services as needed by the City, for a period of one (1) year with an option to renew for one (1) additional one-year period, for an amount not to exceed \$50,000.00; and declaring an emergency therein.

WHEREAS, the City's Purchasing Division has advertised for and received bids for nuisance abatement services as needed by the City; and

WHEREAS, after receiving and reviewing the bids submitted, the City's Purchasing Division has recommended an award of contract to OMAC Hauling Inc. for an amount not to exceed \$50,000.00, which was the lowest and best bidder; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary that this Ordinance become effective immediately in order to avoid an interruption in services, which creates an emergency to preserve the public peace, health, safety and property necessitating the immediate effectiveness of this Ordinance; NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Commission of The City of Springfield, Ohio, at least four of its members concurring:

Section 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with OMAC Hauling Inc. for nuisance abatement services as needed by the City, for a period of one (1) year with an option to renew for one (1) additional one-year period, for an amount not to exceed \$50,000.00.

Section 2. That the contract entered into by the City shall incorporate the specifications prepared by the Purchasing Division, which are hereby approved, and made available to providers submitting bids to the City and shall conform to the recommendations of the City's Purchasing Division as made to this Commission.

Section 3. That by reason of the emergency set forth and defined in the preamble hereto, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately.
